

## “CzechAccelerator 2011-2014, Singapore”

### Additional information on contracting documentation

within the meaning of Section 49(4) of Act No. 137/2006 Coll., on Public Procurement, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”)

This is additional information on the contractual conditions of the under-the-limit public contract "CzechAccelerator 2011-2014, Singapore", specifically pertaining to Article 5, “Requirements as to Evidence of Qualification Criteria Compliance” of the Call for bids and evidence of qualification criteria compliance in respect of the public contract “CzechAccelerator 2011-2014, Singapore” and to Article 5, "Evidence of Satisfying Qualification and Other Criteria” of the Contracting documentation.

The Agency states that the binding version of the technical qualification criteria shall be specified in the Contracting documentation as follows:

*“Compliance with **technical qualification criteria** is to be evidenced as follows:*

*under section 56(2)(a) of the Act, by submitting a list of major services rendered by the supplier **in the last 3 (three) years.***

*The applicant satisfies the technical qualification under section 56(2)(a) of the Act if he has delivered in the last 3 (three) years:*

- ***a minimum of three major service contracts covering the provision of premises and other related services that correspond to the subject of this contract.”***

The Agency **does not require** the minimum of three major service contracts covering the provision of premises and other related services to be related only to foreign companies as set forth in Article 5, "Requirements as to Evidence of Qualification Criteria Compliance” of the Call for bids and evidence of qualification criteria compliance in respect of the public contract “CzechAccelerator 2011–2014, Singapore”.
